From Our Pastor...

"Do You Have A Dream?"

I want to share with you a story of a missionary in Cambodia.

I met a girl in town and began to talk with her. When I just asked, "What is your dream?" she couldn't help but cry. While I was embarrassed, I was waiting for her until she became calm. Then, she barely spoke to me.

"Thank you. Thank you so much. Nobody has asked me before what my dream was. You are the first one."

Lowe Sarai, a 14-year-old girl, who has had to support to six younger brothers and sisters, couldn't have any chance to have a dream, but concerned about daily bread only.

Whenever one of her little brothers and sisters is sick, she is the only one who cares for them. So, she couldn't even dream of going to school and chatting and hanging out with friends. She could not even have imagined what she wanted to be. We are living in a world of abundance, much different from the little girl. While she couldn't dream of her future, we couldn't imagine the lack of the necessities of life in her level. Our financial difficulty and economic depression means are quite different from her situation. In our context, it seems to be natural for us to plan and make small or large accomplishments, but she didn't taste it. Dreaming is still tight for her, but, I believe, it is now so meaningful and precious for the 14-year-old girl, Lowe Sarai.

Then, I want to ask you and myself, "What is our dream?" "What are we, Sterling Wesley UMC, dreaming as the body of Christ?" "Are we dreaming of what our church will look like in five years, ten years, and twenty years?" "Are we dreaming of what our church ministries will be like in our future?" "Are we dreaming of who our children in our Sunday school will become in the future?"

We have a beautiful mission statement of our denomination: "Making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world." And we SWUMC have beautiful and compelling core values; "Serve God," "Nurture Faith," "Experience Friendship." With the mission statement and core values, we need to be dreaming of creating the Kingdom of God in our church, local community, and other places of the world.

I want our church to be a dreaming body of Christ in making disciples of Jesus Christ. I believe, God is vividly working in our community, and the Word and promise of God are still valid in our lives. And God is inviting us to step in God's dream in our church. Then, are we standing with God who is working among us? Are we dreaming with God who has vision and dream in us? I believe we need to stand with God. Would you be willing to dream the dream of God in our community of faith?
