"If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.. (Mark 8: 34)

Mark 8:31-38 reminds us of the radical call to discipleship – inviting us to deny ourselves, take up the cross, and follow Jesus. Lent provides us with an opportune moment to contemplate the depth of this call and discern how we can actively respond in our daily lives.

In the hustle and bustle of modern society, the notion of "giving up" during Lent has often been reduced to relinquishing a particular indulgence. However, the scriptures challenge us to shift our focus from mere abstinence to a more profound engagement with our faith. Instead of fixating on what we lack or sacrifice, let us explore what we can embrace and undertake in the name of Christ.


