An Amazing Promise from God for Today!

I started reading through the Bible this year by reading one chapter in the Old Testament, one chapter in Psalms, and one chapter in the New Testament each day. A while back I ran into this amazing promise in Deuteronomy 28:1-14 that I believe still applies to our lives today. Because in Malachi 3:6, God says through the prophet Malachi, "I the Lord do not change." I believe this promise given to the Israelites also applies today to nations, communities, churches, and families. Take a minute to read this scripture as it was given to the Israelites. After reading the scripture in your Bible, then read here paraphrased versions written in today's vernacular for the church, community, and families.

Paraphrased for the Church - Deuteronomy 28:1-14

¹ If you fully obey the Lord your God and carefully follow all his commands I give you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the peoples of the earth. ² All these blessings will come on you and accompany you if you obey the Lord your God:

³ You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country. ⁴ Those you raise in the faith will be blessed, and the ministries of your church and those you reach will be blessed.

⁵ All the tools and people you need for ministry will be blessed.

⁶ You will be blessed when you come in and blessed when you go out.

⁷ The Lord will grant that the enemies who rise up against you will be defeated before you. They will come at you

⁸ The Lord will send a blessing on your resources and on everything you put your hand to. The Lord your God will bless you in the community he has planted your church.

⁹ The Lord will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the Lord your God and walk in obedience to him. ¹⁰ Then all the peoples on earth will see that you are called by the name of the Lord, and they will revere you. ¹¹ The Lord will grant you abundant prosperity—in the people you raise in the faith, the ministries of your church and those you reach—in the community in which God planted your church.

¹² The Lord will open the heavens, the storehouse of his bounty, to send resources on your congregation in season and bless all the work of your hands. You will give to many but will borrow from none. ¹³ The Lord will make you the head, not the tail. If you pay attention to the commands of the Lord your God that I give you this day and carefully follow them, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom. ¹⁴ Do not turn aside from any of the commands I give you today, to the right or to the left, following other gods and serving them.

Paraphrased for the Community and Families - Deuteronomy 28:1-14

If you fully obey the Lord your God and carefully follow all his commands I give you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the peoples of the earth. ² All these blessings will come on you and accompany you if you obey the Lord your God:

You will be blessed whether you live in the country or in the city. Your children will be blessed. The plants you grow and the animals and their offspring you raise will be blessed - the things that provide for you. Your kitchen and cabinets will be full. You will be blessed when you go out of your house and when you return home.

Your enemies will be defeated; your enemies may come at you in one direction but will flee from you in several directions.

The Lord will bless your wealth and everything you put your hand to or do for work or pleasure. The Lord will bless you in the property he has given you.

The Lord will set you apart for Himself as special. All the people who see you will see that you are special to God, and they will be careful of you. The Lord will give you abundant prosperity in your children, in your crops and animals - the things that provide for you, and your property.

The Lord will open His storehouse in heaven and pour abundance out on you, providing what you need when you need it and bless all you do with your hands. You will have the resources to lend to others but not have to borrow from anyone. God will make you the one who leads and not the one who follows. If you pay attention to the commands of the Lord your God that I give you this day and carefully follow them, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom. Do not turn aside from any of the commands I give you today, to the right or to the left, following other gods and serving them.

May God bless our church, community, and families as we ponder these words from God. I look forward to being with you each of these Sundays.

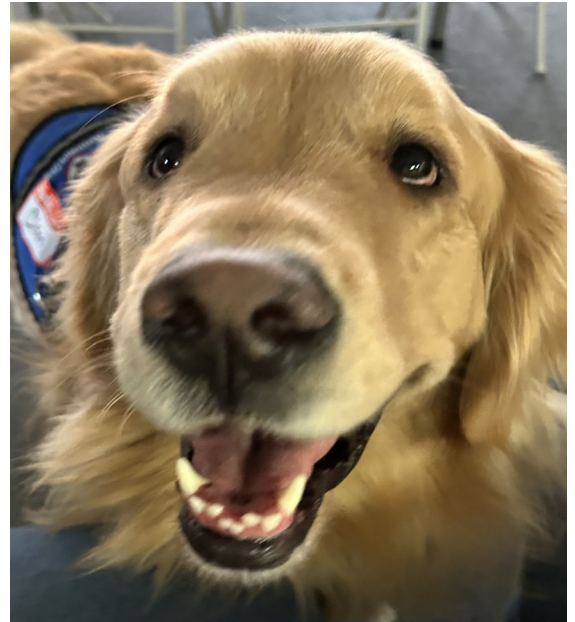
