From Our Pastor...

Greetings, Sterling Wesley Families and Friends,

As we journey through this season of Lent—a time of reflection, repentance, and renewal—I find myself deeply moved by the grace and communion we share with Christ. This grace is not only felt in our spiritual lives but also in our everyday moments, especially in our times of weakness. The Apostle Paul's words, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness" (2 Corinthians 12:9), have resonated with me in a new way, reminding me of how much God's love and grace surround us, especially in the moments we feel most vulnerable.

Life often presents us with challenges that seem overwhelming. Yet, I have come to see that it is precisely in those moments of difficulty and discomfort where God's grace shines brightest. I recall the challenging decision to undergo surgery, a process that began with a series of recommendations and led me to a place where I could experience God's perfect timing and provision. Despite the hurdles, I see now that each step along the way was guided by God's hand, opening doors and connecting me to people who helped in ways I could never have expected.

Through this experience, I was also reminded of the profound gift of community. During my time away for surgery and recovery, I stepped back from my roles as husband, pastor, and member of our larger church community. It was humbling to realize how much I rely on others, yet it also highlighted the overwhelming love and support that

surrounded me. Your ceaseless prayers, thoughtful cards, and prayer shawl lifted me in ways I cannot fully express. I could feel your presence and love, even from a distance. Thank you. I had you in my prayers every day as well. In that time, I learned that community is about mutual care, rooted in God's love.

This Lent, I've gained a new understanding of silence and vulnerability. For weeks, I was unable to speak, and in that silence, I discovered the power of listening—listening to my own thoughts, my wife's voice, and the world around me. Silence became a tool for introspection, allowing me to hear God's voice more clearly. In those moments, I was reminded that God's grace does not require strength but invites us to be exactly who we are—sometimes weak, sometimes vulnerable—so that God's power can fill us.

As we move through this Lenten season, let us reflect on how God's grace transforms our weaknesses into vessels for His strength. Let us embrace the silence, discomfort, and vulnerability as spaces where God's power can be made perfect in us. May we, as a community, continue to extend that grace to others, sharing in communion with Christ and one another.

Thank you for your unwavering support and prayers. May this Lent draw us closer to God's perfect love—always present, always sufficient, and always transforming.




