From Our Pastor

Greetings,

As we move through the sacred journey of Lent into the glorious celebration of Easter, I am filled with gratitude for the ways God's presence is made known among us. This past season has been a time of reflection and anticipation, culminating in the joyous proclamation that Christ is risen!

Throughout this month, we have followed Jesus to the homes and tables of those he encountered—Simon the Pharisees and the unnamed woman, Mary and Martha's home in Bethany, the upper room where he broke bread with his disciples, and the road to Emmaus where his presence was revealed in the breaking of bread. Each of these meals speaks not only of nourishment but of divine presence, of relationships restored, and of the abundant grace that Jesus offers. 
